



YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR SUBSIDIZED PRICING & OTHER SUPPORT SERVICES

If you receive any of the below-listed benefits or fall below the income requirements listed in the table, you qualify for subsidized pricing at the Veterinary Clinic and Mobile Vaccine Clinics. In addition, you are eligible for a Spay/Neuter Voucher and the Food & Supply Pantry Program*.

To qualify for subsidized rates or additional support services, clients are required to present evidence of financial hardship or active enrollment in a government aid program before receiving services.

+Spay/Neuter Vouchers and Food Pantry Program have additional requirements in addition to income qualifiers. *Non-Disability Social Security must qualify based on overall income. See chart above. Participating in MCHA's assistance programs will not affect the government assistance that you receive.
